The carrier is rated "A" by A.M. Best and is non-admitted.

Risks located in Connecticut, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Maine and New Hampshire are eligible. Coastal risks defined as those within 1000 feet and one mile from the nearest body of salt water are acceptable. However, further discretion will be allowed for certain New England regions such as Narraganset Bay.

Coverage includes but is not limited to fire, extended coverage, allied lines, special causes of loss excluding flood and earthquake. WKF&C has binding authority up to \$2Million per location. Minimum deductibles of \$1,000 will apply for TIV up to \$1Million and \$2,500 for TIV greater than \$1Million. Wind deductibles are one percent to two percent as defined by certain areas and regions.
